## **COMMUNITY** Impact

Through our 350+ programs, our network of subsidiaries, our various partnerships with government, foundations, businesses and community-based organizations, the work of PHMC impacts every household in Philadelphia.

The combined annual impact of PHMC and its subsidiaries on the Philadelphia community's economic vitality is estimated to be in the range of \$600 million. PHMC and its subsidiaries have an annual gross revenue of more than \$400 million.
